Grant Stewart of American Ship Management, Chair, called the public meeting to order at 10:10 and welcomed those in attendance. The secretariat confirmed the presence of a quorum. The following committee members or alternates were in attendance. Len Cardoza, Port of Oakland; Denise Turner (alternate for John Davey), Port of San Francisco; Tom Wilson (Port of Richmond); Brian Dorsch, ChevronTexaco; Scott Merritt, Foss Maritime; Michael Beatie, Golden Gate Bridge District, Ferry Division; Larry Teague, San Francisco Bar Pilots; Margaret Reasoner, Crowley Maritime; Margot Brown, National Boating Federation; Mari na Secchitano, Inlandboatman's Union of the Pacific; Joan Lundstrom, Bay Conservation and Development Commission; and Kathyrn Zagzebski, The Marine Mammal Center. Also present were U. S. Coast Guard representatives, Capt. Larry Hereth (MSO); Sean Kelley, (VTS); U. S. Army Corps of Engineers representative, Jim Delorey; OSPR representative, Al Storm; NOAA representative, Michael Gallagher; and Marine Exchange/Clearinghouse representative, Lynn Korwatch. In addition, more than thirty representatives of the maritime community and interested public were present.

The following corrections were made to the minutes of the 11-8-01 meeting. **A. Storm**: P. 1, attendees should include NOAA representative **Mike Gallagher**. P. 2, OSPR Report, last paragraph, references to the two pamphlets being published should indicate that they were developed by the Human Factors Work Group and the Prevention through People Work Group and that the work groups will submit them both to the HSC for approval. P. 3, should read: . . . which will reduce costs associated with travel <u>from Sacramento</u>. **S. Kelley**: John Caplis is a Lt. Cmdr. and Dave Kranking is a Cmdr. MOTION by L. Teague, seconded by B. Dorsch, to approve the minutes as corrected.

The following corrections were made to the minutes of the 12-13-01 meeting. **J. Lundstrom** (as submitted by **N. Salcedo**): P. 1, **Nick Salcedo**, BCDC, alternate for **J. Lundstrom**, was present. Throughout the minutes COPT should be corrected to read <u>COTP</u>. P. 1-2, Coast Guard Report, vessel names should be capitalized. P. 2, 1. 8, delete the apostrophe in <u>radars</u>. P. 2, OSPR Report, the organization referred to is the Oil Wildlife <u>Care Network (OWCN</u>). Last line of that report and first line of Ferry Operations work Group, meetings held <u>on</u>, rather than in the referenced date. P. 4, Prevention through People Work Group Report, 1. 7, mew should be <u>new</u> and there is no apostrophe in <u>ones</u>. P. 4, Tug Escort Work Group, the vessel referenced is the <u>ACOAXET</u>. **A. Storm**: P. 3, in the discussion of the oil slick, the minutes should read: "The 8-mile long slick <u>appeared</u> off the coast between Point Reyes and Half Moon Bay <u>and disappeared</u> the next day. Preliminary indications are that this may be bunker fuel and <u>not a cargo leak</u>." **L. Cardoza**: P. 3, Underwater Rocks Work Group Report, third and fourth lines should read: "The

<u>Risk Model is underway to determine probability and actual risk of a grounding and associated</u> <u>risks. The Benthic Survey is complete and on the Port website.</u>" For consistency, Corp should be <u>COE</u>. In references to the EIS/EIR and administrative draft, they are <u>completed</u>. **J. Caplis**: P. 1, Coast Guard Report (3), "... the GAZ DIAMOND was bound for the Port of Stockton under the provisions of a COTP order because she was carrying hazardous cargo, when she was temporarily redirected to Anchorage 9 to repair inoperative radar." **M. Secchitano** recommended pages be numbered for ease of reference. MOTION by **J. Lundstrom**, seconded by **S. Merritt**, to "approve the minutes of the 12-13-01 meeting as amended and corrected."

USCG COTP'S REPORT, L. Hereth (1) John Caplis: A written report of port operations statistics for pollution response and investigations and significant port safety events for the period December 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001 is made a part of these minutes. Question: Is there more information on port security? L. Hereth: Work group efforts on guidelines for shore side security are coming together. Participants are close to striking an agreement on benchmark interim standards to be in place for the next one to one-and-a-half years, until the Maritime Security Act, SB 1214, passes into law. The Senate passed it unanimously and it will go to the House in the next session. The CG has started the regulatory process, beginning 1-28-02 to develop maritime security regulations. The West Coast effort to develop standardized guidelines in step with that effort. Interim guidelines for west coast terminal operators are expected to go to them soon. Terminals will then have sixty days to have plans on line and then the CG will revisit the terminals to see the plans in place. Question: Is the CG meeting with the ports on a weekly basis and is there a system for screening crews getting on and off vessels? L. **Hereth**: Regarding the gangway watch, the economic implications mean that it won't happen until the regulations are out. Gangway watches will cost facilities/operators millions of dollars and can only be required and implemented in an official regulatory way. Question: Are there new regulations being developed to change the rules for using anchorages in SF Bay? L. Hereth: In the short term, vessels, particularly ammonia carriers, will not go to anchorage-the CG doesn't want them sitting around in the middle of nowhere. Strategy meetings are being held looking to prevent a USS COLE type incident and these vessels will be directed to move directly to Sacramento/Stockton. Question: Is it true that other vessels can't approach vessels at anchorages? L. Hereth: Yes, if a security zone has been established and is being enforced by the CG. The CG is still trying to work through this with agents in a sensible way to address the delivery of stores. The CG doesn't expect to have to establish many security zones because vessels with hazardous cargo will, whenever possible, go direct to berth. J. Caplis: A regulation was developed to establish moving security zones around passenger and tank vessels. The referenced Port Security Bulletin will be included with the minutes of this meeting. A second bulletin addressing the reporting of suspicious activity will also be attached to these minutes. L. **Hereth**: When an individual reports suspicious activity to the CG, the CG will automatically forward the report to local law enforcement agencies and the FBI. The bulletin includes twelve activities that may arouse suspicion. The list is not all-inclusive, but will provide guidance to employers for instructing employees on what to look for. There is no requirement for reporting to the CG, but reports to the CG will be shared around. The bulletin also includes an 800 number for reporting an actual terrorist incident. Question: Is the CG involved in Senate port security hearings being chaired by Senator Breau? L. Hereth: The agenda has not been set yet. The CG will forward it to the MX for distribution when it is available. Hearings are tentatively scheduled for 2-18-02, LA; 2-19-02, Oakland; 2-21-02, Portland; and 2-22-02, Seattle. Jerry

Karr, Valero, reported that he was on the water 12-17-01 doing a survey and was approached by two CG vessels. They very thoroughly and professionally investigated. **L. Hereth**: It is a huge challenge to strike the delicate balance necessary to address security needs and respect individual's privacy rights. The CG will continue to try to do the right thing.

CLEARINGHOUSE REPORT, A. Steinbrugge. (1) A written report with statistics for the month of December 2001 is made a part of these minutes. There were no calls to OSPR during the month of December and no calls from pilots to report the arrival of a vessel without escort paperwork. The CH is contacting the agencies that had vessels arrive unprepared for tug escort planning.

OSPR REPORT, A. Storm. (1) **A. Storm** swore in **J. Lundstrom** and her alternate **Nick** Salcedo for another three-year term. No other committee members' terms expire in 2002. Todd Covini will be replaced by Capt. I. A. (John) Karakoulakis of SeaRiver, as alternate to Stewart McRobbie. As yet, there is no alternate for the environmental representative. (2) The San Mateo mystery spill has been occupying the interest of OSPR and is being aggressively investigated. This may be happening all year, but only noticed annually with winter conditions. 4/5 of the 1000 birds found oiled were already dead or died in captivity. Question: How does the number of lost birds compare to the actual number of birds in existence? K. Zagzebski: There is no word of populations being wiped out or of endangered species being threatened. However, there is no way of knowing how many birds or animals may die out of sight. A. Storm: OSPR has quantified data and produced it in a map format that is updated regularly. Question: This event seems to be associated annually with huge swells; does the oil come from the sunken PUERTO RICAN? J. Caplis: It's being studied. Samples don't match the PUERTO RICAN. Rick Holly, Supervisor of Field Operations, OSPR: The San Mateo mystery spill has changed the way OSPR does business. Specialists from all over California have become involved. OSPR is working with VTS, looking at vessel movements, analyzing traffic patterns, looking at various wrecks, looking at prioritizing taking samples of vessels and analyzing crude coming to Bay Area oil facilities. The gut feeling is that this is a good-sized dump that didn't just happen. K. Zagzebski: The most highly endangered species aren't impacted, but we are looking at 5% population decreases of some species, with all dying animals not necessarily identified. The volunteer coordinator's hotline in Cordelia for working on the wildlife clean-up program is 707-207-0380 x 107.

NOAA Report, M. Gallagher. No report.

COE REPORT, J. Delorely. The text of the COE Report is made a part of these minutes. There has been no change in the status of the Avon Turning Basin Project because of funding issues. With the change of ownership of terminals, there will be further delays. There have been no changes in the status of the Oakland 50' Project or the James Baldwin Channel Project since the December HSC meeting. The next survey of Bulls Head Channel is scheduled for April. There have been no noted changes since the last survey. **M. Beatie**: The ferry companies are concerned with the reduction of debris removal in the bay. **L. Cardoza** reported that he works with the administration and the California Congressional Delegation to fund dredging and maritime-related construction and maintenance funding, including the corps' debris collection mission in the bay. Concerned parties should address their concerns to their elected representatives in Congress.

NAVIGATION WORK GROUP REPORT, L. Teague. A good system for getting chart information within days of surveys has been successfully developed because the issue was brought to this forum. This is not true upriver, however, because that is a different COE district. **E. Dohm** and **M. Gallagher** look to address this in the future.

UNDERWATER ROCKS WORK GROUP REPORT, L. Cardoza. (1) Robert Flowers,

Commander, U. S. Army COE, visited SF Bay on 1-4-02 for a ceremony and was taken on a harbor tour and briefed on the work of the HSC. (2) Oakland 50' Project. The first contract is on budget and a couple of days ahead of schedule. The second contract, for additional demolition and expansion construction is out for bid. (3) The written report of the Underwater Rocks Work Group is made a part of these minutes. The report should be corrected to indicate that the CG was represented at the 1-8-02 meeting. In addition, in the paragraph referencing the status of the EIS/R, it should be noted that the shoaling at Alcatraz will be reduced under an operations and maintenance program, separate from any project to lower Harding, Shag, Arch, and/or Blossom Rocks.

FERRY OPERATIONS WORK GROUP REPORT, M. Beatie. A meeting is scheduled for 1-23-02 at 10:00 at the State Lands office to arrive at final wording and size for the signage the group has been working on, then it will come back to the HSC.

HUMAN FACTORS WORK GROUP. No report.

PREVENTION THROUGH PEOPLE WORK GROUP, M. Brown. (1) *Guide to Recreational Vessel Marine Communications* will not be reprinted in the near future because it's too expensive. There are 30,000 on order in the first run and, after they are distributed to marinas and yacht clubs, the remaining copies will be stored at the MX. *Where the Heck is Collinsville* is progressing well. The next work group meeting is scheduled for 2-7-02 at State Lands. **M. Brown** has a schedule of the sailboat races planned for 2002, rated A/B/C based on their impact on traffic lanes, high/medium/none. **M. Gallagher**: The group did great work on the Collinsville brochure. He submitted it to *Coast Survey* for inclusion in their publication, but they won't accept any names that differ from those designated by the Geographic Place Names Commission in Washington, DC. They will report on any conflicts. **J. Delorey** noted that there is a website with the names of all geographical locations that can be found by doing an Internet search for 'geographical locations''. **M. Brown** added that, with this information, the work group will hold up until more information is received.

TUG ESCORT WORK GROUP REPORT, J. Lundstrom. The work group's next meeting is scheduled for 1-15-02 at 10:00 at State Lands. The main focus of the meeting will be the tug/tanker matching matrix, taking into account information from **David Gray**'s November presentation, including sea trials results. Also available to the group is a report the MX has prepared a report on the mix of tanker trade in the bay, which includes 128 different tankers, and SFBP **Capt. Gregg Waugh**'s report on the ACOAXET incident.

PORTS REPORT, A. Steinbrugge. The Oakland wind sensor problems may require that the instrument has to go back to the manufacturer. Efforts will be made to minimize down time. A. Steinbrugge is getting the equipment together to troubleshoot the Oakland current sensor and he will be out with a boat and divers in a week or two. The Benicia side-looking sensor deployment has been pushed back to April due to problems with manufacture of the prototype. A. Steinbrugge is hoping, with NOAA support to get the existing sensor with the broken cable working. L. Teague: There has been up to a two-hour difference between predictions and actual currents. That sensor is very important. L. Korwatch: A. Steinbrugge has been working with NOAA to put a survey on the PORTS website to identify users. They hope to have it on the site within the next couple of weeks. The survey information is necessary to validate the use of the system and it is important for future funding efforts that everyone complete that survey. L. **Teague**: Pilots rely on the system, but access it by phone rather than the website when actually piloting. Question: What is the status of funding? **L. Korwatch**: The \$35,000 from Boating and Waterways will fund the Benicia and Oakland sensor work. The state doesn't have much money, so the future is uncertain. The HSC will be updated when any new information is available.

OLD BUSINESS. None.

NEW BUSINESS. (1) The Chair announced that **R. Holly** will make a presentation on BC States Oil Spill Prevention Vessel Routing, with graphics, at the next HSC meeting and will provide additional information subsequent to his earlier presentation last fall. The meeting time will be changed to 9:30 to accommodate this presentation, which will come after the business of the committee has been addressed. (2) The next Human Factors Committee meeting will be held on 1-15-02 at State Lands to go over the steering and propulsion workbook. (3) Question: Can the HSC send a letter to Bay Area Congressional representatives regarding the importance of funding for debris removal on the bay? The chair placed the issue on the agenda for a vote at the next HSC meeting. The Ferry Operations Work Group will develop a draft letter for committee consideration. (4) Question: Can the HSC send a letter to Contra Costa County Supervisors regarding the importance of the proposed Avon Turning Basin? The chair placed the issue on the agenda for a vote at the next HSC meeting. The rest HSC meeting. The Navigational Work Group will draft a letter for committee consideration.

The next meeting of the HSC will be held at 0930 hours at the Port of San Francisco on 2-14-02.

MOTION by **B. Dorsch**, seconded by **L. Teague**, to "adjourn the meeting." Motion was passed without objection. Meeting adjourned at 1140.

Significant Cases:

ONGOING -- The USFWS, USCG, and CA OSPR continued to manage efforts to recover and rehabilitate oiled sea birds found along the coast of Northern California throughout the month of December. As of 10 January 2002, a total of 1178 birds (690 dead, 488 alive) had been collected.

02 DEC – M/V APL SCOTLAND (SN) failed to provide dangerous cargo manifest to USCG National Vessel Movement Center in accordance with advance notice of arrival requirements. COTP Order was issued prohibiting vessel's entry into port until all required information was provided. Subsequently, vessel agent provided manifest and COTP Order was rescinded.

03 DEC – T/V SAN SEBASTIAN (CY) had inoperable ARPA radar and insufficient lifeboat rations during Port State Control boarding. COTP Order was issued ordering vessel to proceed to Anchorage Nine and complete repairs and reprovisioning. Vessel agent coordinated full ARPA repair and reprovisioning of lifeboats and COTP Order was rescinded.

09 DEC – M/V APL CYPRINE (SN) failed to provide dangerous cargo manifest to USCG National Vessel Movement Center in accordance with advance notice of arrival requirements. COTP Order was issued prohibiting vessel's entry into port until all required information was provided. Subsequently, vessel agent provided manifest and COTP Order was rescinded.

12 DEC – M/V PACIFIC ROYAL (PN) grounded while loading cargo in the Port of Stockton. The vessel was allowed to move to a lay-berth for a hull damage survey. The diver's summary reported that the hull was in good condition and there was no damage to the rudder or propeller. Vessel departed Port without incident.

14 DEC – T/V GAZ DIAMOND (PN) was issued a COTP Order requiring a letter of undertaking or surety bond for \$27,500, the maximum civil penalty for the vessel's failure on 30 NOV 01 to report a hazardous condition aboard, specifically, that its primary and secondary radars were inoperable during its entry into San Francisco Bay. Subsequently, vessel agent coordinated delivery of satisfactory letter of undertaking to MSO SFB and COTP Order was rescinded.

14 DEC – T/V GAZ DIAMOND (PN), laden with a bulk cargo of anhydrous ammonia, was issued a COTP Order requiring the vessel to proceed directly to its scheduled cargo reception facility (Port of Stockton) without anchoring. COTP Order's primary purpose was to minimize risk of terrorist activity posed by a vessel carrying bulk commodities of certain highly flammable or toxic cargoes. COTP Order was rescinded after T/V GAZ DIAMOND discharged its cargo without incident.

14 DEC – M/V C.S. VALIANT (PN) crew failed to perform an adequate fire drill during a Port State Control boarding. COTP Order was issued requiring the crew to conduct an adequate fire drill before a USCG marine inspector. Vessel's crew performed satisfactorily and COTP Order was rescinded.

14 DEC – T/V NAMSAN SPIRIT (BM) suffered a steering system casualty while anchored in Anchorage Nine prior to transiting to Avon Refinery, Martinez, California. COTP Order was issued requiring proof of satisfactory repair before vessel would be allowed to depart Anchorage Nine. Vessel agent coordinated full repairs and COTP Order was rescinded.

21 DEC – M/V MATSONIA (US) suffered a steering system casualty while outbound to sea. Three tugs assisted during vessel's return to Anchorage Nine. Local Matson Port Engineer and American Bureau of Shipping coordinated full repairs and provided repair report to MSO SFB.

30 DEC – T/V GAZ DIAMOND (PN), laden with a bulk cargo of anhydrous ammonia, was issued a COTP Order requiring the vessel to proceed directly to its scheduled cargo reception facility (Port of Stockton) without anchoring. COTP Order's primary purpose was to minimize risk of terrorist activity posed by a vessel carrying bulk commodities of certain highly flammable or toxic cargoes. COTP Order was rescinded after T/V GAZ DIAMOND discharged its cargo without incident.

Port Security Information Bulletin #001

Restricted Use of Anchorages in Port

In order to reduce our vulnerability to terrorist attacks, the Coast Guard has implemented certain restrictions on vessel movements within the port. Vessels carrying bulk commodities of certain highly flammable or toxic cargoes will be restricted in their ability to use anchorages in San Francisco Bay.

- 1. All tank ships loaded with <u>Anhydrous Ammonia</u> will not be allowed to anchor within San Francisco Bay. Anhydrous Ammonia loaded tank ships entering port are required to proceed directly to their intended offload facilities.
- 2. All loaded tank ships carrying <u>highly flammable</u> cargoes will be restricted in their ability to use anchorages in the port. The Vessel Traffic Service (VTS) and the SF Bar Pilots will communicate these restrictions to the vessel master at the time of arrival.
- 3. In certain circumstances, the Coast Guard may provide waterside security utilizing its patrol craft while vessel is at anchor or berth. While vessel is under such waterside security, <u>all</u> vessels scheduled to attend or visit the secured vessel must contact Coast Guard Group San Francisco Operations Center at (415) 399-3451 for proper clearance. This includes <u>all</u> visits by pilot vessels, supply vessels, water taxis, or vessels for bunkering purposes.





Reporting Suspected or Actual Terrorist Incidents



The National Response Center (NRC) has been established as a national point of contact for reporting **suspected and actual terrorist incidents**.

Help us stop terrorism <u>before</u> it happens!!

Suspicious Activity Examples:

- 1. Unknown persons photographing facilities.
- 2. Unknown persons attempting to gain access to facilities.
- 3. Unknown persons loitering in vicinity for extended periods of time.
- 4. Suspicious individuals establishing businesses or roadside food stands either adjacent or in proximity to facilities.
- 5. Unknown persons calling facilities to ascertain security, personnel, or standard operating procedures.
- 6. Vehicles with personnel in them loitering and perhaps taking photographs or creating diagrams of facilities.
- 7. Small boats with personnel on board loitering and perhaps taking photographs or creating diagrams of facilities.
- 8. Suspicious general aviation aircraft operating in the proximity to facilities.
- 9. Unknown persons attempting to gain information about facilities by walking up to personnel or their families and engaging them in a conversation.
- 10. Suspicious vendors attempting to sell merchandise.
- 11. Theft of facility vehicles, vehicle passes, personnel identification, personnel uniforms, or standard operating procedures.
- 12. Theft of standard operating procedure documents.
- 13. Unknown or suspicious workmen trying to gain access to facilities to repair, replace, service, or install equipment.
- 14. Suspicious E-mails on internet, public affairs attempting to obtain information regarding the facility, personnel or standard operating procedures.
- 15. Suspicious package drop offs/attempted drop offs.
- 16. Anti-American sentiment being expressed by employees or vendors.
- 17. Anti-American pamphlets, or flyers distributed to employees or placed on windshields in parking lots.






Total Escort Movements in San Francisco Bay for 2001




Zone 1 Totals for 2001

Report of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, San Francisco District

10 January 2001

1. CORPS 2002 O&M DREDGING PROGRAM

- **a.** *Main Ship Channel* March April 2002 timeframe Corps dredge Essayons scheduled to perform this work.
- **b.** *Richmond Outer and Southampton* March April 2002 timeframe Corps dredge Essayons scheduled to perform this work.
- c. *Richmond Inner* May June 2002 time frame.
- d. *Oakland* (*Inner & Outer*) June July 2002 timeframe.
- e. *Suisun Bay Channel* June July 2002 timeframe.
- f. San Rafael This is a congressional addition to the Corps budget.
- g. Petaluma This is a congressional addition to the Corps budget.
- h. Larkspur Carry over from last year.

2. DEBRIS REMOVAL

The total tonnage of debris collected on the San Francisco Bay for December was approximately 137 tons. This is down from the 180 tons for November. The Raccoon is down because of rudder damage. Temporary repairs are expected to be completed by the end of next week. Permanent repairs will take place at the end of the month and will require drydocking. The Grizzly and Seahawk remain in service full time.

3. UNDERWAY OR UPCOMING HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS

a. **Oakland 50-ft** – Construction is underway. Corps has awarded the first Construction contract for first demolition and the contractor has started work.

Corps has scheduled bid opening for second contract for 23 January 2002. The second contract will cover the Inner Harbor Turning Basin Phase I A-2. The Corps has received approximately 8.4 million dollars for the project this year.

b. S.F. Rock Removal Feasibility Study -

Benthic Survey has been completed. The 50% Administrative Draft of the EIS/R has been completed and reviewed by the Corps. After revisions are made, the Corps will provide to the other Agencies. Alternatives formulation will be a major portion of work for the 100% Administrative Draft.

Risk Assessment methodology (Position Paper) has been approved by Corps Headquarters on 24 April 01. A contract for a Risk Model has been awarded or is eminent.

c. Avon Turning Basin.

Status unchanged.

Congress added \$250,000 this FY to prepare a General Reevaluation Report (GRR) and evaluate the feasibility of constructing a Turning Basin at Avon. This Basin is part of the un-constructed Phase III, John F. Baldwin Ship Channel project. To initiate this study the COE has prepared a Study Plan and has submitted a draft 50/50 cost sharing agreement to Contra Costa County, for their consideration. Contra Costa County is negotiating with the users of the two terminals at Avon (Ultramar Diamond Shamrock and Shore Terminals) to obtain funds for their portion of the cost sharing. There appears to be a problem with getting a cost sharing agreement for this project since it has been under consideration for some time. The Corps will continue to work with Contra Costa County on this issue.

4. EMERGENCY DREDGING

We continue to monitor the problem area in the Suisun Channel that has required emergency dredging in the past. We just completed a hydrographic survey that showed this area to be ok. The information has been provided to the pilots. Next scheduled to be surveyed in early April.

5. CORPS' BUDGET

Corps has received the funds for projects scheduled this year. We are in the process of assessing the adequacy of the funds for completing our projects. The Corps budget contains congressional additions for San Rafael and Petaluma maintenance dredging.

6. OTHER WORK

The San Francisco District and the Sacramento District are looking at a joint feasibility study to deepen the JFB Ship Channel from Avon to Stockton. This would be only 1 or 2 feet. Reconnaissance Study was performed a couple of years ago. Division has given ok to proceed with study. Details of the study still need to be worked out.

The San Francisco District of the Corps needs a cost-sharing partner for this project. There is a meeting scheduled next week with Contra Costa County to see how this cost sharing might be funded.

<u>Summary:</u> The Underwater Rocks Work Group held a meeting on January 8, 2002 at the California State Lands Commission offices, Hercules, CA. The central theme for the meeting was the status of the Corps of Engineers (CoE) Feasibility Study (FS) for the project. Attendees for the Rocks Work Group included representatives from the Corps of Engineers (CoE), FS consultant team members, California State Lands Commission (CSLC), Port of Oakland, San Francisco Bar Pilots, and Congressman Miller's Office.

Status of Contracts. Attendees discussed the status of contracts required for the FS.

- Risk Model. Funding is in place. The CoE will award the contract to the firm EQE. Anticipate a three month duration.
- Benthic Survey. Complete. Final Report is posted on the CoE web site.
- Oil Spill Model. Draft report is anticipated by the end of January 2002.
- Geotechnical Analysis. As previously reported, the CoE was not able to come to an agreement with the consultant team on cost and scope of work. The CoE is proceeding with a literature search based on previous geotechnical investigations in the area. This approach will control costs and provide sufficient level of detail for the feasibility study. The information will be used to refine the scope of work for additional geotechnical analysis during the design phase of the project.
- Marine Geophysical Investigation. Complete. The report has been posted on CoE web site.
- Cultural Resource Survey. Complete. The report has been posted on the CoE web site.
- San Francisco District, Corps of Engineers web site. <u>www.spn.usace.army.mil/</u> Go to publications/studies for reports referenced above.

<u>F-3 Conference.</u> The CoE is preparing the project documentation for the Feasibility Study 3rd Milestone (F-3) conference. This is the first conference with the CoE leadership above District level, also referred to as the Feasibility Scoping Meeting, The CoE anticipates scheduling the F-3 in February 2002. The conference will focus on the present project area conditions, and the economic analysis / risk assessment for the project, together with preliminary alternatives analysis.

<u>Status of EIS/R</u>. The 50% Administrative Draft EIS/R was submitted to the CoE on 5 December 2001. The COE met with the consultant and CSLC, the local sponsor for the project, on 18 December 2001 to review the document. The next step in the EIS/R process is the development of a list of alternatives to prevent groundings on the rock mounds in Central San Francisco Bay near the existing deep-draft channels. The alternatives may reflect three general categories, in addition to the no project alternative:

• Rock reduction. Reduce (lower) all or some combination of the identified submerged hazards to navigation (Harding, Shag, Arch, Blossom Rocks and the unnamed shoal west of Alcatraz Island). The rock reduction alternative will also include discussion and analysis of alternative methods for removal and disposal.

- Re-align / construct new channels. Dredge to widen and deepen existing San Francisco Bay Traffic lanes
- Operational Restrictions. Incorporate the work by the Harbor Safety Committee to continue to refine tug escort regulations and/or other operational restrictions (vessel speed, piloting, two way traffic, etc.).

The alternatives will be evaluated on the basis of efficiency, effectiveness, cost, and acceptability. The selected alternative may involve some combination of the above (rock removal/operational restrictions/channel re-alignment)

The CoE agreed to work with the CSLC to develop a draft preliminary listing of alternatives by the next Work Group Meeting.

The attendees also discussed methodology of reducing the rocks (boring/tunneling/blasting; abrasion). Alternatives for the disposal/re-use of the excavated rock rubble will also be an important consideration.

There may be impacts to navigation associated with the extensive anchoring systems required for work (detailed geotechnical investigation; boring/blasting; excavation of rubble).

Although the CoE has initiated consultation with the Federal Resource Agencies (Fish and Wildlife Service, National Marine Fisheries Service), the Coordination Act Report (CAR) will likely not be complete without a fully developed set of alternatives, analysis of each, and associated plans for mitigation/monitoring.

<u>Budget/Schedule</u>. Delays in developing a listing of alternatives, together with baseline environmental conditions (including fisheries resources) may impact the FS schedule beyond the completion date of 5/27/03. The CoE will analyze schedule implications.

<u>Meetings.</u> The next Underwater Rocks Work Group meeting is scheduled **February 19, 2002, 1000hr - 1200hr** (CSLC Offices, Hercules, CA). The meeting will focus on the listing of project alternatives discussed above.
