Capt. Grant Stewart, American Ship Management, Chair, called the public meeting to order at 10:05 and welcomed those in attendance. The secretariat confirmed the presence of a quorum. The following committee members or alternates were in attendance: **Len Cardoza**, Port of Oakland; **John Davey**, Port of San Francisco; **Tom Wilson**, Port of Richmond; **Nancy Pagan**, Port of Benicia; **Stuart McRobbie**, SeaRiver Maritime; **Doug Lathrop**, ChevronTexaco; **Fred Henning** (alternate for **Scott Merritt**), Baydelta Maritime; **Capt. Larry Teague**, San Francisco Bar Pilots; **Joan Lundstrom**, Bay Conservation and Development Commission; and **Margot Brown**, National Boating Federation. Also present were U. S. Coast Guard representatives, **Cmdr. Steve Boyle** and **Lcdr. John Caplis** (MSO), **Cmdr. David Kranking** (VTS); U. S. Army Corps of Engineers representative, **David Dwinell**; **Al Storm**, OSPR; **Ken Leverich**, State Lands Commission; **Cmdr. Steve Thompson**, NOAA; and **Lynn Korwatch**, Marine Exchange and HSC Secretariat. In addition, more than twenty representatives of the interested public were present.

Corrections to minutes of 2-13-03 meeting. **L. Cardoza**: In Underwater Rocks Work Group Report (1), first two sentences should read "Regarding the Oakland Project, the omnibus bill for all appropriations that didn't pass Congress is going through now with \$12 million for Port of Oakland O&M 50' Project and O&M funding for Port of Oakland federal channels and other projects. The President's budget for FY 2004 only includes \$7 million for the Oakland Development Project and \$6.8 million for Port of Oakland O&M." **Joan Lundstrom**: Tug Escort Work Group Report, in motion language change "in San Francisco Bay" to "to San Francisco Bay"; and after the motion language, add See report made a part of these minutes for work group findings. **M. Brown**: In second to last sentence of Underwater Rocks Work Group Report, correct "in necessary" to read "is necessary"; and, the second sentence of the Prevention Through People Work Group Report (1) should read "On Monday, there was a notice posted ~~at the terminal~~ available on the ferry announcing no service that day on Monday". MOTION by **M. Brown**, seconded by **J. Lundstrom**, to "approve the minutes as corrected." Motion passed without objection.

In opening comments, the Chair thanked **Captain Swanson** for making Coast Guard facilities available for this meeting.

USCG COTP'S REPORT, S. Boyle. (1) **S. Boyle** introduced senior staff members to the committee and each gave a brief description of their responsibilities: **Lt. Lexia Littlejohn**, Planning Department; currently working on port security planning process, which includes a vulnerability assessment report. A draft plan will be available for review by early summer.

Tony Davis, Investigations; responsible for investigating marine casualties and enforcement. It is important that individuals involved in incidents submit 2692's for the statistical history of port events and input into the development of possible recommended changes. **George Bufflaben**, Chief, Regional Exam Center; responsible for issuing mariner credentials, approximately 4300 per year in this area. Currently, changes are being implemented in the merchant mariner documentation program, including complete background checks prior to issuing documents. New ID cords will be non-tamperable. Question: Are they available now? **G. Bufflaben**: Yes. **Lcdr. Judy Persoll**; responsible for safety and security. Approximately 500 safety inspections are conducted annually on foreign and domestic vessels, including ferries, from the Oregon line to San Louis Obispo. Security is addressed through the Sea Marshall Program and review of vessels' 96-hour advance notice of arrival. **Cmdr. Jeff Seine**, Port Intelligence Coordinator; responsible for making sure maritime stakeholders have all the information that is available, in order to operate securely. He stressed the importance of input from the community and maintaining a high level of awareness. **Cmdr. Greg Phillips**, staff officer assigned to the COTP; responsible for port security issues and knowledge of international and national issues that impact the local area. **Lcdr. John Caplis**, Chief Port Operations. **Lt. Ross Sargent**, Response Division. (2) **J. Caplis** reported on port operations statistics for pollution response and investigations and significant port safety events for the period February 1, 2003 through February 28, 2003. A written report is made a part of these minutes. The Carquinez Bridge Project is going well and will continue for another two to three months. Security zones around the Golden Gate and Bay Bridge continue to be in effect. In the event war is declared, the local CG has no information to date on what will actually occur. **S. Boyle**: Regarding reports that the port would be closed, the COTP can exercise port control if security levels are raised. That doesn't mean that the port will literally be closed. (3) Question: What is the status of the passenger ship discharge issue in Monterey? **M. Lebsack**: The CG has some enforcement authority within the marine sanctuary and may participate in a support role, but the marine sanctuary has the lead for enforcement. There is no proof of a violation of marine sanctuary regulations. Question: Did the CRYSTAL HARMONY report the discharge? **M. Lebsack**: Yes, they are required to and they were not "caught", they reported as required. The company signed an agreement last summer not to discharge in the sanctuary. (4) Question: In January, the CG report included information on the grounding of the SS MAUI in the Oakland estuary. Where was it? **D. Kranking**: The ship was perpendicular to the channel. The grounding was not due to shoaling. The vessel ran outside the channel. (5) **D. Kranking**: Added a review of VTS role to the CG responsibilities described earlier. VTS is headquartered on Yerba Buena Island. Regulations require that all passenger carrying and commercial traffic advise of their movements. VTS gathers information from camera sensors and radio reports, covering 40 miles outside the Golden Gate Bridge to Sacramento/Stockton. VTS is a unit of the 11th CG District, operationally subordinate to MSO COTP, serving as his 'eyes and ears'. The Program Manager, Washington, DC, conducts the customer satisfaction survey that was sent out in the last couple of weeks. Completed surveys should be returned to Washington, DC; see **K. Kranking** for copy.

(6) **D. Kranking** reported on the next generation of upgrades to VTS equipment (PAWSS). The upgrades will replace existing radars, VTS Center equipment and remote sensors, piece-for-piece. The Pt. Bonita tower is to be rebuilt in the summer or fall in order to accommodate the new equipment. VTS SF would like to add an additional radar site at Pt. Reyes and camera sites in Oakland and Richmond. Upgrades to NY and Houston are scheduled for 2003, along with a new installation in Port Arthur, TX. The actual date for SF upgrades is unknown due to budget issues related to “deep water” acquisition and plans to recapitalize money for fleet upgrades. In the future, the HSC may want to encourage the California Congressional Delegation to promote bringing the upgrades to SF.

CLEARINGHOUSE REPORT, A. Steinbrugge. A written report with statistics for the month of February 2003 is made a part of these minutes. There was one call to OSPR during the month of February for a possible escort violation and one call from a pilot to report a vessel arriving at the pilot station without escort paperwork. The pilot had forms available and the vessel was able to proceed. Year-to-date, there was one call to OSPR regarding an escort violation. There were two calls regarding escort violations in 2002; six calls in 2001 and five calls in 2000.

OSPR REPORT, A. Storm. (1) Minutes of the last HSC meeting did not indicate that, while **A. Storm** was not able to attend, a member of OSPR staff was present. OSPR makes an effort to have **A. Storm** or **R. Holly** attend every meeting. (2) On 3-3-03, **Harlan Henderson** resigned as Administrator of OSPR for personal reasons. **Carlton Moore** currently serves as Acting Administrator. He is a retired CG Admiral who has been in the OSPR program, off and on, since 1991. He has served as Director of Boating and Waterways and has good corporate knowledge of OSPR. **Scott Schaeffer** continues to serve as Deputy Administrator and **Bud Leland** continues to hold the position of Assistant Deputy Administrator.

NOAA REPORT, S. Thompson. (1) Five new charts have been issued: 18651, South SF Bay (2-24-03); 1866, Sacramento and San Joaquin Rivers (2-27-03); 18663, San Joaquin River, Meford Island to Stockton (1-5-03); 18652, small craft portfolio, SF Bay to Antioch (3-4-03); and 18656, Suisun Bay (3-4-03). (2) There were policy discussions regarding including security zones on charts. Permanent zones will be included and, where the zones are too small in comparison to the scale of the chart, there will be a note on the chart. Descriptions will also be included in the *Coast Pilot*. Long-term temporary zones will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. NOAA will also produce handout chartlets, with the changes to scale for ease of reference, for distribution at marinas, etc. (3) A chart verification team with survey capabilities will be in SF area for six months beginning in November. **S. Thompson** wants input from pilots, facilities and operators regarding any changes or work that needs to be done in order to develop a work schedule. Steven.A.Thompson@noaa.gov; 415-561-6624.

COE REPORT, D. Dwinell. The text of the COE Report is made a part of these minutes by attachment.

STATE LANDS COMMISSION REPORT, K. Leverich. (1) February was a typical month for inspections and security work. (2) State Lands has a new, more powerful, database for tracking. (3) This month State Lands will begin a review of the cooperative agreements between the CG, OSPR and State Lands. (4) On 2-22-03, state security regulations for oil terminals were made permanent. They track closely with NAVIC.

Request by Western States Petroleum Association (WSPA) for voting representation on the SF Bay HSC. To date, three letters have been received addressing this issue. Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company sent a letter dated 1-31-03 requesting the HSC create a seat to represent the interests of the independent marine oil terminals and refineries. WSPA sent a letter dated 2-10-03 making the same request and asking that the seat be held by a WSPA member, further nominating **Jerry Karr**, Valero, to hold the seat and **Capt. Marc Bayer**, Tesoro, to be appointed as his alternate. **J. Karr** has indicated his desire to remove his name from nomination. On 3-13-03, Valero sent a letter requesting that the HSC create a new position to represent the interests and concerns of all marine oil terminals and refineries, nominating **M. Bayer** for the position and **Capt. Esam Amso**, Valero, as alternate. **A. Storm** reviewed the process for adding new members to the HSC. In 2001, AB 715 allowed for five at-large seats to be created for each HSC because the existing legislative mandate did not fit every HSC venue/area. This new provision allows HSC's to adjust their membership to represent the local maritime community. In SF, one of those five seats has gone to Ferry Operators, a group outside the original statutory constraints; leaving four seats. If the SF HSC wants to create a new seat, the committee must send a letter to the Administrator with the request and the reasons for the request. Once the position has been approved by the Administrator, the nomination process is open for applications to be submitted. OSPR makes the selection from the nominations submitted. The Chair posed questions for consideration: Will adding a new seat strengthen and improve the committee? Should the proposed terminal representative be from independent terminals or represent all terminals? Question: Does OSPR recommend that the committee be enlarged? **A. Storm:** OSPR has no position. Question: What is the length of the application period? **A. Storm:** None is set in law. It should be as open as possible. The open position would be announced at two successive HSC meetings, in an e-mail to the MX list and with the announcement of HSC meetings. The application period would probably be 45 days. Copies of all three letters referred to earlier regarding a terminal representative seat were distributed to all committee members. Question: Why was the proposed position left out when the HSC was created? **S. McRobbie:** When the HSC was created, tanker and barge interests were represented. Shipping interests owned the terminals. With changes in the industry, not all terminals are represented by shipping interests. Ship security, port security and terminal security must all mesh. Questions: Should there then be a dry cargo representative? With the increase in passenger ship traffic, should there

be a terminals representative plus another shipping interest? How closely does the Port of Oakland represent dry cargo interests? **G. Stewart**: There are a lot of questions and the Chair would like to appoint a work group to look at the membership issue and changes in the demographics of the industry and develop a recommendation for the May HSC meeting. **J. Lundstrom**: SF should look at LA/LB and their definitions. SF HSC needs definitions in order to request the Administrator's approval of an additional seat, clearly stating who is qualified to hold the seat. MOTION by **M. Brown**, seconded by **T. Wilson** that "the Chair appoint a work group to study the addition of a seat, possibly to represent terminal operators, and to examine all implications thereof." Motion passed without objection. The Chair appointed **J. Lundstrom** to chair the work group. Volunteers to serve on the work group: **S. McRobbie**, **T. Wilson**, **L. Teague** and **D. Lathrop**. **A. Storm** suggested that it might be helpful to see someone from dry cargo interests included.

USCG Recreational Boating Sub-Committee Pilot Program Presentation. This presentation was postponed until later in the meeting due to presentation equipment malfunction. It was later postponed until the May or June HSC meeting.

NAVIGATION WORK GROUP REPORT, L. Teague. Nothing new, work is on-going

UNDERWATER ROCKS WORK GROUP REPORT, L. Cardoza. (1) Congress passed the omnibus bill and it was signed by the President. The Port of Oakland 50 foot project continues to go well and larger vessels are continuing to turn. The port remains concerned about execution of the O&M program. **Col. McCormick** is making the process work and **L. Cardoza** applauds Value Engineering for looking at the O&M project. **L. Cardoza** will go to Washington, DC again, with representatives of other California interests, seeking dredging funding. The key issues are dredging and safety. (2) The Underwater Rocks Work Group held a meeting on March 11, 2003 and the report is made a part of these minutes. The bottom line is that it is unlikely that the Chief of Engineers will sign a positive report. The work group developed three alternatives and discussed them at length. Participants agreed that the preferred alternative was to terminate studies and close the Feasibility Report and that is the likely outcome. This might result in a useful product and conserve funding. The next step is for State Lands, the non-federal cost sharing sponsor, to meet with the COE to obtain additional information concerning all the alternatives discussed.

FERRY OPERATORS WORK GROUP REPORT, N. Pagan. No report.

PREVENTION THROUGH PEOPLE WORK GROUP, M. Brown. The next meeting is scheduled for 3-19-03 in Hercules. A subsequent meeting is tentatively scheduled for 4-9-03.

TUG ESCORT WORK GROUP REPORT, J. Lundstrom. No report.

PORTS FUNDING WORK GROUP. **S. Merritt** will report at the next meeting.

PORTS REPORT, A. Steinbrugge. The Oakland current meter is up and operational thanks to the help of **S. Thompson**. The on-going project to install an experimental side-looking meter on the Benicia Bridge has fallen back again. The low-tech alternative is still progressing; with no actual installation date identified yet due to some installation hurdles. The Golden Gate tides station will be reinstalled in a month or two, making real-time information available again. The schedule is dependent upon the Park Service completing the pier rebuild project. **L. Teague** : Attention to the Benicia station is appreciated. It's the most useful site for pilots, especially with spring run-off.

OLD BUSINESS. None.

NEW BUSINESS. (1) **L. Korwatch** provided a meetings update. The next MTS meeting will be 3-20-03 at 10:00 at the Port of Oakland, First Floor. On 3-21-03 the Propeller Club will hold a security symposium at the World Trade Club from 8:00 to 1:30. The first week of April the CG will be hosting the Annual HSC meeting. They are looking for lessons-learned material and chairs of SF HSC work groups are encouraged to submit reports outlining the work of their groups. **L. Korwatch** will attend. An award will be presented for the HSC of the year. Last year New York City received the award in honor of their involvement in response efforts after the September 11th terrorist attack. (2) **L. Cardoza** reported on the work of a group he chairs (Compounding Factors Work Group) that is looking at issues and factors that prevent efficient and effective dredging to develop the best management strategies and practices without compromising quality. (3) **M. Brown** provided the 2003 Yacht Racing Association schedule, organized by date and risk (level of interference with shipping channels). Opening Day on SF Bay will be Sunday, April 27th.

The next meeting of the HSC will be held on 4-10-03 at 10:00 at the Port of Richmond.

MOTION by **T. Wilson**, seconded by **L. Teague**, to "adjourn the meeting." Motion was passed without objection. Meeting adjourned at 1150.

Significant Cases:

04 FEB – M/V STARLING suffered a propulsion casualty and was ordered to remain at anchorage until repairs were made. Vessel’s classification society cleared repairs and vessel was allowed to depart.

05 FEB – T/V GAZ BALTIC suffered a failure of its #1 generator lube oil cooler, causing approximately 200 gallons of oil to leak into the raw water system discharge overboard. Pollution team dispatched to assist MSRC in clean-up coordination. COTP Order issued requiring vessel to stay moored until investigation complete. Repairs completed on vessel and cleared by classification society. Oil clean-up and investigation was completed; COTP Order was rescinded.

22 FEB – T/V CEFALONIA, laden with bulk liquid fertilizer, ran aground in the San Joaquin River and allided with Beacon 49 while bound for Stockton. COTP Order was issued requiring vessel to have divers locate the position of Beacon 49 and to have its classification society conduct a hull survey for structural damage. Vessel submitted an acceptable salvage plan, refloated successfully and proceeded to Stockton with COTP permission. COTP Order was rescinded; vessel departed port 12 MAR. Causal investigation continues.

1. CORPS 2003 O&M DREDGING PROGRAM

Corps has submitted a Master Sampling and Analysis Plan along with individual Sampling and Analysis Plans for each Corps project to the DMMO agencies for approval of this years Sampling and Testing Program. We expect to obtain approval of these within the next few weeks.

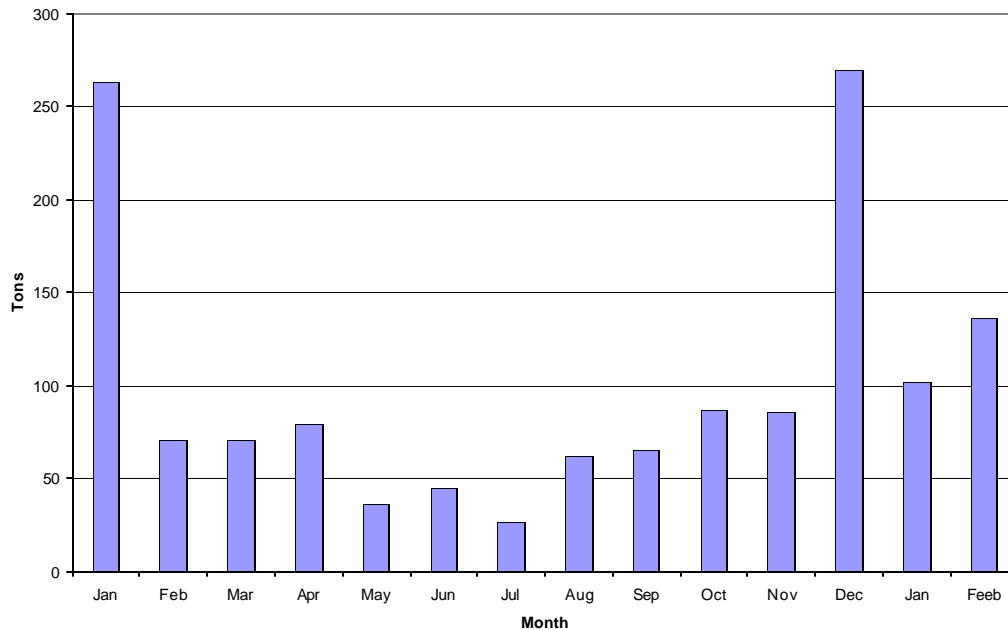
- a. ***Main Ship Channel*** – Expect to start dredging in early June 2003. Government dredge *Essayons* is scheduled to perform the work.
- b. ***Richmond Outer and Southampton Shoal***– Expect to start dredging in early June 2003. Government dredge *Essayons* is scheduled to perform the work.
- c. ***Richmond Inner*** – Project will be restarted on May 8, 2003 pending final approval of National Marine Fisheries Service. This will be a continuation of the FY 2002 contract. Material is scheduled to go to the ocean and U.S. EPA has requested that the Corps perform confirmatory chemistry testing on the material.
- d. ***Oakland (Inner & Outer)*** – Corps is coordinating O & M dredging with the deepening project time line. Material is scheduled to go to the ocean. The Corps plans to do full testing on the material this year. Work is scheduled to start mid July.
- e. ***Suisun Bay Channel/Pinole Shoal/New York Slough*** - Expect to start dredging approximately mid July. Corps is working with Department of Water Resources to take the material to Sherman Island. One concern for taking the material to Sherman Island is rather there will be sufficient material to perform the pilot project. The pilot project requires 150,000 cubic yards of material. At present, there is only about 116,000 cubic yards of material including the entire over depth. If the permits and paper work is not in place to support taking the material to Sherman Island, the material will probably go in bay.
- f. ***Redwood City*** – Not scheduled for dredging this year, but Corps is working with Port and Pilots to address problem areas of channel. One solution may be to do advanced maintenance in the problematic area of the channel.

- g. **San Rafael** – Contractor continues to work on this project. The Corps has permission to dredge through March using an environmental bucket and a silt curtain.
- h. **Petaluma** – Dredging stopped February 5, 2003 due to the Endangered Species Act. Contractor has demobilized for the site. There is approximately 20,000 cubic yards of material remaining on this project. We plan to resume dredging when window opens August 1, 2003.
- i. **Pinole Shoal** – The Corps did not receive sufficient funds for this project to stand alone. Therefore, this project will likely be combined with the Suisun Bay/ New York Slough dredging contract or will be performed by a government dredge. There may be other options the Corp can explore to complete this project.

2. DEBRIS REMOVAL

The total tonnage of debris collected on the San Francisco Bay for February 2002 was 136 tons. This is up from the 102 tons collected in the month of January. One question left over from last month's report is progress being made on a new Debris Removal Boat and how is this project coming along. The Corps is in the process of finalizing the plans for the design. This is being done at the Philadelphia Marine Design Center. At the present time the design is for a boat with a more rapid response time.

3. UNDERWAY OR UPCOMING HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS

a. Oakland 50-ft –

Construction has been continuing under the continuing resolution authority. Corps has modified the contract to keep construction going until budget was passed. There is 12 million in this year's budget for the Oakland project minus what has already been spent and saving and slippage. With this level of funding the Corps plans to let two additional contracts this year. One for the demolishing of a building and one for dredging.

b. S.F. Rock Removal Feasibility Study

The Corps has completed Risk Model that gives the probability of an accident occurring. At present the Risk Model shows the risk to be small. It is difficult to capture the catastrophic nature of an accident if it should happen based on the way the BC is required to be calculated. Based on the present information the decision has been made to put out a final report so the work that has been accomplished can be of use in the future and then to stop work. This does not preclude this project from being pursued by a different means.

c. Avon Turning Basin – Status Unchanged

Corps does have concerns that we could lose the money for this project and the opportunity to complete this project.

The Corps expects to sign a Pre-construction Engineering Design (PED) cost sharing agreement with Contra Costa County on this project. However, we understand that Contra Costa County has given up on the oil companies and will work to form an assessment district to obtain the funds. Forming an assessment district may take some time. Funding will allow this project to start moving forward.

Congress added \$250,000 this FY to prepare a General Reevaluation Report (GRR) and evaluate the feasibility of constructing a Turning Basin at Avon. This Basin is part of the un-constructed Phase III, John F. Baldwin Ship Channel project. To initiate this study the COE has prepared a Study Plan and has submitted a draft 75/25 cost sharing agreement to Contra Costa County, for their consideration.

4. EMERGENCY DREDGING

None in FY 2003.

5. CORPS' BUDGET

Corps has received the FY 2003 budget for O & M Dredging and is currently in the process of evaluating it. It appears that we will have sufficient funds for our O & M projects this year. We have not yet received funds for the congressional additions to the budget. Therefore, we have a general idea of what we will receive for the congressional additions, but do not know what funds will be held back for savings and slippage.

6. OTHER WORK

Status Unchanged – Study is ongoing.

The San Francisco District is looking at a feasibility study to deepen the JFB Ship Channel to Stockton. This would be only 1 or 2 feet. Reconnaissance Study was performed a couple of years ago. Division has given ok to proceed with study. The Corps signed the Pre-construction Engineering Design agreement with the Port of Stockton on July 11, 2002. This started the Phase 1 study on salinity and economics. This study is expected to take approximately 10 months. Department of Water Resources is performing the study and the Corps has already provided some of the funds.

Status Unchanged – Work is continuing.

The San Francisco District has taken over the Sacramento River Deep Water Ship Channel Deepening Project from the Sacramento District. This project is looking at deepening the channel from 30 feet to 35 feet. Corps has developed a Project Management Plan (PMP). We were scheduled to sign a concurrence on PMP in September, but that did not happen. It is being rescheduled. We will be doing a Limited Revaluation Report (LRR) that focuses on economics and updating the environmental documentation. We have initiated this project. The studies should take approximately 18 months.

I am writing to request that the San Francisco Harbor Safety Committee create a seat to represent the interests of the independent marine oil terminals and refineries. These facilities have a direct and significant impact on navigation safety and on the safety of the environment and surrounding communities in San Francisco Bay. Each marine terminal and refinery maintains a ship and or barge dock, conducts soundings, performs maintenance dredging, and supports and uses the PORTS system. The companies that operate these marine facilities vet ships and set rules and regulations which govern the quality and management of tankers and tank barges that call at the facilities. Every marine facility maintains extensive oil spill response equipment with fully trained and staffed crews on call 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Additionally, these terminals make up the majority membership, and fund the oil spill coops that grace San Francisco Bay with the best oil spill cleanup capability in the world. All of these terminals and refineries have marine operations departments staffed with ex-mariners with extensive knowledge of tank vessel and tank barge operations.

The Harbor Safety Committee does not currently include representation from marine oil terminals and refineries, yet they accounted for 3,474 tank vessel and tank barge movements in the bay in 2000. We have no representation, but are asked to sponsor dredging projects, and participate in forums that benefit the entire marine community. We seek your support in creating this position.



Subject: Underwater Rocks Working Group Report

The Underwater Rocks Working Group held a meeting on March 11, 2003 at the California State Lands Commission offices (CSLC), Hercules, CA. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the F-3 Conference report reflecting the Corps of Engineers (CoE) Feasibility Study (FS) for the project. Attendees for the Rocks Work Group included representatives from the CoE, FS consultant team members, CSLC, Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC), NOAA Fisheries, U.S. Coast Guard Vessel Traffic Service, San Francisco Bar Pilots, San Francisco Bay Marine Exchange, and Port of Oakland.

As previously reported, The Corps of Engineers (CoE) held the F-3 Conference for the San Francisco Bay Rock Removal Project on January 23, 2003. The purpose of the conference was to review the results of the Feasibility Study to date; certify, if possible, the "without project" conditions (baseline data); and conduct a technical review of the supporting documents. The conference led to the following conclusions:

1. The risk assessment model for the study resulted in a cost benefit analysis significantly below the 1:1 ratio required to proceed with CoE projects under the concept of National Economic Benefit (NED). Therefore, it is extremely unlikely that the Chief of Engineers will provide a positive recommendation for the proposed project.
2. It is also unlikely that the Corps of Engineers will pursue the project's structural alternative (rock removal) under the Federal objective for National Ecosystem Restoration (NER). The FS documented that an oil spill in the San Francisco Bay will have devastating environmental impacts. However, characterizing the prevention of these impacts as environmental restoration is problematic, from the perspective of the CoE. Although prevention of these impacts is a potential project output, CoE Principles and Guidelines for project formulation might not consider these outputs as environmental restoration. The outputs result from preventing an accident rather than restoring the environment.
3. The project proponents should consider expanding the scope of the study to consider means to prevent oil spills as a result of all causes (not limited to grounding on the submerged rocks to the northwest and southeast of Alcatraz Island).
4. The study will likely conclude that other, non-structural measures (such as employing additional tractor tugs) should be pursued. It is unlikely that the Federal Government will fund these non-structural measures as a CoE civil works project.

The Working Group agreed on the following alternatives with respect to completing the Feasibility Study:

1. Cease all work. Recommend that the CoE Commander/Division Engineer issue a Public Notice stating that work on the Feasibility Study has been terminated due to the extremely low benefit to cost ratio. Provide copies of completed and incomplete work products to the non-Federal cost sharing sponsor (CSLC).
2. Terminate studies. Complete work nearing completion to a logical (useful) point. Prepare Feasibility Study document stating conclusions noted above. Recommend that the CoE Commander/Division

Engineer issue a Public Notice stating that the Feasibility Study is complete with the recommendation that there is no Federal interest due to the low benefit to cost ratio.

3. Expand scope of Feasibility Study to include means to prevent oil spills as a result of all causes (not limited to grounding on the submerged rocks to the northwest and southeast of Alcatraz Island).

Following is a summary of the Working Group's discussion on the three alternatives outlined above:

1. Cease work. Under this alternative, a significant amount of work may be lost, and would not result in a product that would be useful for decision-makers to explore alternative means of funding a project to reduce the hazards to navigation (rocks). The participants could not support this alternative.
2. Terminate studies, close Feasibility Report. The participants agreed that this alternative might result in a useful work product while conserving scarce funding.
3. Expand scope. This alternative might duplicate existing work by other working groups within the San Francisco Bay Area Harbor Safety Committee. It would probably require additional funding and time without providing significant information that would increase the benefit-to-cost ratio.

Next steps. The CSLC, as non-Federal cost sharing sponsor will meet with the CoE to obtain additional information concerning the alternatives listed above (including but not limited to remaining budget, level of effort, and likely expectations).

Next meeting. To be determined.
